Our MarkSmarf^{IM} recycled rubber foundation mats are the cost-efficient alternative to expensive brick & other systems on your ball field. Installing mats 1-2" below grade effectively limits "dig-in", reduces field prep time, eliminates puddling at the plate or on the mound.

Shipped in one carton with Eight 16"x 20" mats per set


Easy Installation:

- 1. Place mats at desired locations.
- 2. Score an area about 3/4" larger than configured mats.
- 3. Remove mats and dig out that area about 3"- 4" deep.
- 4. Re-insert mat, backfill with surface dirt & tamp area.
- 5. You're ready to play!



After digging the area out and Before installing foundation mats, using a bulb auger (try our **GSA-12**), drill 12 drain holes per mat - approx. 1" dia. x 10" deep Fill holes and 1" of the excavated areas with


water absorbent infield conditioner




Using our 8 pack sets here are some options for installation

Spot Coverage - uses mats horizontally Full Coverage - uses mats vertically




For Softball (Fast or Slow Pitch)




Little League Economy Option
